The first scheduled work party is Saturday, March 20, 8am—12pm

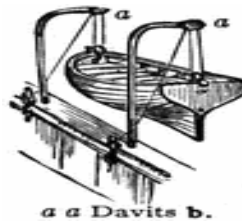

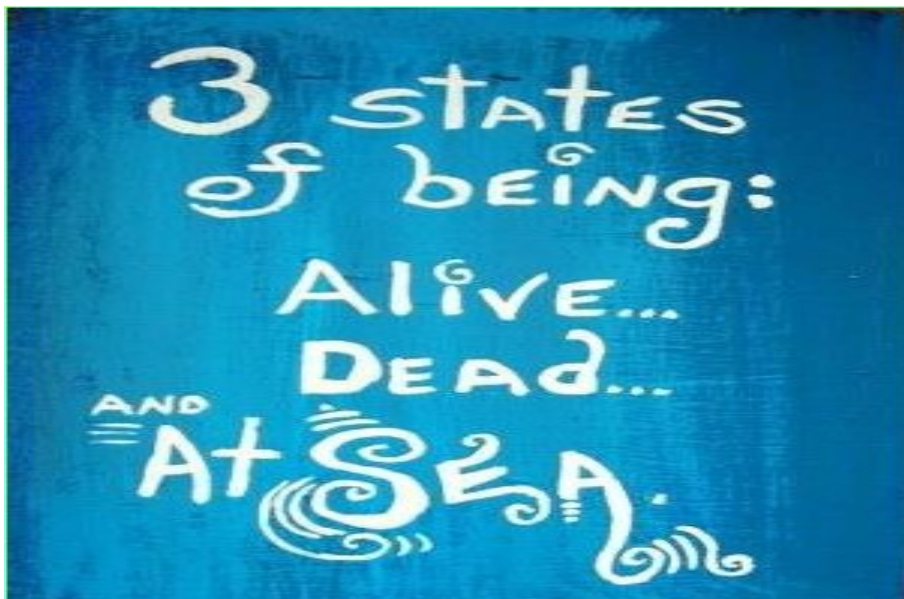
