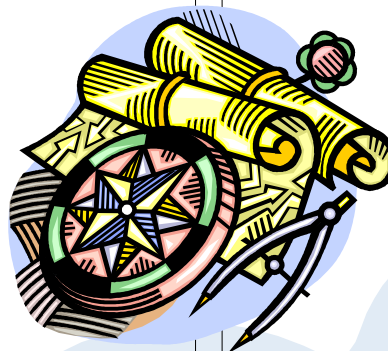

We seem to have survived the winter without any major mishaps. All open moorage and boathouse spaces have been awarded, and things are quiet.

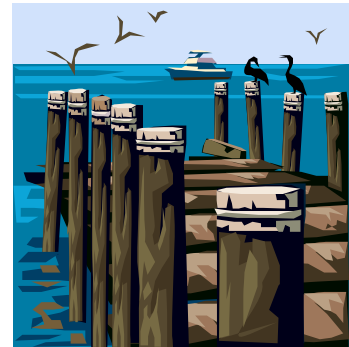
