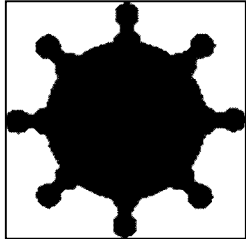

painting the window trim (Jan Stumph, Liz McCallister and Quita Perry)

Now that we are nearly finished with the preparation, the June 14th work party seems a good date for application of the primer (weather permitting), if you are interested, please dress appropriately.

I also need two or three volunteers to cut, caulk and then attach the outside window trim (call me at 636-1276).
