This was one of our best cruises yet. I would like to particularly thank the First Lady for all of her efforts organizing and hosting the cruise. The poker run was a great time and had good participation from both clubs. Thank you to Jerry Norton for the great blueberry pancakes Sunday morning. I would also like to recognize and thank Ron Evans for all of his effort to design and build the float that represented LYC in the parade. It takes a lot of personal time to make these kinds of projects a success and a success it was, we were able to take second place, Great Job Ron!

I had a call from the DNR this last week regarding the designation of water dependant or non-water dependant uses of the boat houses and club house at LYC. The DNR's position is now that they don't plan to change any of the designations for the club or any of the houses. They want to maintain the good relationship we have and appreciate how we work with them in an open and honest manner. This does not change the fact that our annual lease fees will increase over the next four years from the approximately \$1200 a year to just a bit over \$8000. We got a very good rate for many years as we

were compared to a marina that didn't actually exist any longer. As a reminder for everyone, these rate increases will be implemented in increments of approximately \$2000 a year until we are at the rate at which we should be paying. Since it was such a significant change the DNR did not want to hit us with the increase all at once, again, part of our good relationship with them. Also as a reminder, what the increase means to all of us as members, is that our annual dues will be increasing over a four year period as well. There are two big social events coming up this month. We have a pot luck dinner before the general membership meeting on August 11th and we have Cheeseburgers in Paradise on Saturday August 23rd. This has been a great event during the last few years and this year will be no exception, you won't want to miss it. Some of you will be asked to

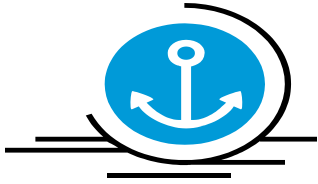

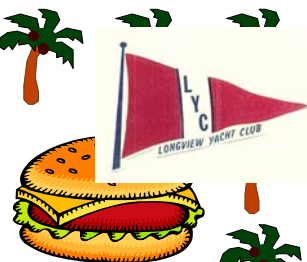
