check their boats and tie up lines before the start of winter. It is very important for all members to watch for any unusual things around the club

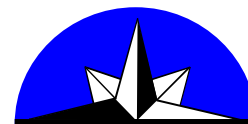

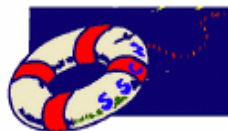
