Dear Commodore, Officers, and Members of The Longview Yacht Club:


On behalf of our Commodore Dennis Teeter, and the officers and members of The Yakima Valley Boat Club, I wish you the best of boating in the coming year.

Parking, at no charge, is available just outside of our gate. It is just a short walk to our rest rooms, picnic area, and docks. The US Forrest Service limits parking in this area, and anywhere in the national Forrest, to fourteen consecutive days.

Our campground provides tent spaces, fire-pits & fire wood, picnic tables, a cooking shelter, rustic rest rooms, and beach access. We have wonderful scenery, friendly members, great fishing, and lots of dock space. If you arrive by boat, tie up in any space not marked "Reserved." We do not have power, water, boat fuel, or garbage pickup -- so bring what you need and please haul out what's left. Our facility does not accommodate RV camping but, should you wish to visit us in your camper or motorhome, there are several commercial and U S Forrest Service RV facilities in the area.

If you will honor us by identifying yourself as a member of your club and flying your club burgee we will do our best to make you welcome.
